MEETING MINUTES
March 3, 2021

New Albany Borough Council held a monthly meeting at the New Albany Volunteer Fire Department Social Hall on March 3, 2021. The meeting was called to order at 6:01 p.m. by President Michelle Dunham.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Approval to pay bills was presented to Council. Dave Manley made a motion to pay the bills. Sheena Pettitt seconded the motion. Roll call vote: all responded "yes", motion carried. Council Members reviewed the Treasurer's Report. The report was accepted by the President and it was placed on file for audit.

PUBLIC INPUT: Individuals complaining about the drug issue in the Borough. Commenting that nothing is being done about it.

Then it is continuing down through the center of the intersection. Mayor Dan suggested utilizing the PennDot Agility Program for repairs that need to be done on Main Street and May Street. The Borough will clean drains, sweep streets, shovel snow from the Route 220 bridge sidewalks, etc. in repayment for work performed by PennDot.

PARK: Nothing to report.

SEWER: Nothing to report.

WATER: No frozen lines so far this winter!

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Tabled voting on the Fawcett Avenue Bridge project until the March 17, 2021 meeting.

Council President Michelle Dunham reported that the non-profit organization that helps veterans, The Fans of America Foundation, is still interested in purchasing the nine properties of Chris Allen's that are for sale in the Borough. This organization is based in South Carolina with a mission to provide services to veterans; which includes, housing, health care, education, training, and employment.
